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A SPIRITUAL ROAD TRIP

A spiritual road trip. An existential show. A theatrical experience with three stops: Hell, Purgatory and Heaven. For the first time, a Greek theatre company tackles the finest work to come out of medieval Europe.

VASISTAS theatre group will present *The Divine Comedy*, Dante's monumental "visionary autobiography", his imaginary journey through the kingdom of the dead.

Faced with the sheer volume of Dante's trilogy, VASISTAS create a highly concise version of Dante's text by selecting those sections that convey its deeply personal qualities: the difficult journey made by one individual, from the dark ordeals of the everyday, through times of painful crisis, to life's light-filled moments of escape; from immersion in a world of shadows, to an exit towards the light.

On stage, a tight, core group of performers will take on the narration by expanding the codes developed over recent years by VASISTAS, who place the expressive power of the body and the musical dimensions of choral forms at the heart of their practice.

Adding to its musical explorations, the performance will feature a string quartet, integrated in the scenic action.

Minimalism and electronica will interact live, with the use of modern means, thus contributing to the concoction of this particular theatrical experience: *The Divine Comedy* road trip.

*The poet and translator Nikos A. Panagiotopoulos is a profound connoisseur of medieval tradition and litterature and an important figure of contemporary Greek littearature scene. Since late 1985, he was exclusively dedicated to the writing of his opus incertum, a long narrative of free lines, intitled « Syssimon or the chapters ». At the same time he is involved in the formation of Greek contemporary theatre through important collaborations with Lefteris Vogiatzis, Michael Marmarinos or the young artist S.Kakaklas. His personal study, his point of view, his connexion with psiritualities who formed the interior life of greek people (D. Karambelas, Eleftherotypia, 2009) and his translations of Greek tragedies and writers who defined the spiritual landscape of world's littearature, maked of him the ideal partner for the study, the treatment and deconding of this text for its first stage direction in Greece.

VASISTAS theatre group

The theatre group, based in Athens, works between Greece and France, creating theatrical performances that encounter contemporary life and aim to research and experiment on stage's action. Searching for dramaturgies that are not defined by a text-based logic or in a linear story-telling, and with little use of technical means, the group orchestrates «moving images» in detail, creating a rhythm for an experience, like a music choreography in present time.

The team of VASISTAS is now composed by Argyro Chioti (co-founder of the collective and artistic/stage director), Ariane Labed and Naima Carbajal (co-founders of the collective), Efthimis Theou, Eleni Vergeti, Antonis Antonopoulos, Georgina Chriskioti, Evdoxia Androulidaki.

VASISTAS theatre group received for Spectacle the honors distinction of National Association of Critics of theatre and music, (for innovating theatre play) (December 2011). Argyro Chioti received the Price "Eleftheria Sapoutzi" for her artistic work (September 2013).

"Collecting its texts from the world of tales, myths, literature, science but also the theatre, the research of VASISTAS develops methodically with a clinical precision around the form of a polyphonic choreography which is reminiscent of Brecht's epic model: the choral form makes us move from dialogue to narration, from performing actor to witness."
